Meeting Minutes May 16th, 2022

Call to Order: The meeting was called to order at 6:59PM by Steve Niebler, President. There was no Pledge of Allegiance given due to several board members being virtual.

PRESENT: In Person: Steve Niebler, Tom Demko, Keith Ulrich and Erin Peddigree Virtual: Jimmy Phelps.

ABSENT: Max Laing, Steve Toddes, and Robin FitzPatrick

The agenda was presented for review.

The April Meeting Minutes were presented for review and approval. Tom Demko moved, and Keith Ulrich seconded approval of the minutes as distributed. Motion carried unanimously.

PUBLIC COMMENTS: No public comments.

Erin Pedigree provided the Treasurer's Report in lieu of the Treasurer's absence. The report of which was in today's packet. The financials suggest that we are in line with the budget. Unanimous approval followed.

New Business- No new business.

Erin Pedigree submitted the Director's Report which was included in today's packet. Erin reported that a zero-turn mower was purchased for \$16,400 from Harrington's. A push trimmer was also purchased from Lowe's. Erin reported that she is still looking for a tractor, utility vehicle, and golf cart from the \$52,500 from the Borough. The maintenance staff are very busy with mowing and preparing all the fields for baseball and softball. Erin

reported April rental numbers and reported an increase this year in building rentals. The park has been very busy between baseball, rentals, and returning events. World Classroom busses have returned and will becoming consistently at the end of May until the first week of August. Most of the month of May there have been many school trip pavilion rentals. The Primary elections will be held on May 17th in the assembly room and the blood mobile will be in the parking lot May 26th. Library Fun Fest will be held in the park on June 10th and Juneteenth following the weekend on June 17th. Erin met with the Gettysburg Brew Fest about a potential event at the park. Brew Fest will email Erin and let her know their plans. The Farmer's Market committee met to discuss potential layout if the Farmer's Market. The Farmer's Market wanted to use the assembly room more often and we discussed concerns about using the assembly room too much and taking away from rentals. The committee discussed other options in the park for the Farmer's Market and price of using the assembly room at times. Erin is working on several grants for the restrooms and for a new playground area due next year. The Fireworks committee met and planning is still going on for the July 4th celebration and events. Erin met with Officer Glenny from the Gettysburg Borough to discuss help on July 4th and the use of electronic vehicles in the park. GARA board decided that electric vehicles are allowed in the park as long as there are no issues with speed and no motorized vehicles are allowed in the park, such as motorbikes.

Board Comments: Additional thanks to GARA staff for maintenance around the park.


