The meeting was called to order at 7:06 PM by Steve Toddes, Chair. The meeting was held via Zoom.

**Jake Schindel moved and Keith Ulrich seconded that the agenda be approved as distributed. Motion carried.**

**Robin Fitzpatrick moved and Keith Ulrich seconded that the minutes of the February 8, 2021 meeting be approved with the addition of Jennie Dillon and Kathy Gilbert added as representing GARMA. Motion carried.**

Erin Peddigree presented the financial report. **Jimmy Phelps moved and Keith Ulrich seconded that the financial report be filed for audit. Motion carried.**

The Board discussed the Fourth of July fireworks presentation which is being coordinated with the Gettysburg Rotary Club, the Gettysburg Area Retail Merchants Association (GARMA) and GARA. Parking will be available at 6:30 PM and it is expected that the fireworks will be launched at 9:30 PM. We'll charge \$5.00 to park, \$6.00 with the use of a credit card. There is a lot of interest from vendors. There will be help with parking and EMS services

Jake Schindel explained that the Borough and surrounding municipalities will be receiving COVID relief funds from the federal government. He urged the Board to study and pursue a community pool in the park.

Steve Toddes noted that election of officers should occur at the next meeting and that he would support someone else being elected President.

Erin is continuing to pursue an attorney for GARA.

Jake Schindel noted the Borough would not be expending money for legal fees for the research that needs to be done to locate the Library in the Park.

Erin reported that the we are looking at the cost of reseeding the football field, Len Dick Signs had offered to donate a new sign for the corner of the park and that March usage of the facilities was very strong.

Jake Schindel suggested that we look into planting trees along the edge of the park that borders the Catholic cemetery. He also suggested that the slope of the Amphitheater be increased.

Max Laing noted that there are several football programs using the Warrior name. Erin offered to speak with them to attempt to alleviate confusion that exists.

As always, Board members thanked Erin for her continued hard work on behalf of the Park and its programs.

**There being no further business, Jimmy Phelps moved and Keith Ulrich seconded that the meeting be adjourned at 8:10 PM. Motion carried.**
